### ABOUT LARRY ANDREWS

Larry Andrews is a Senior Capital Projects Executive and Partner for Corpus Optima. His broad success in the field includes over 40 years experience in the project management of engineering, procurement and construction at domestic and international locations in the petrochemical, refining, power generation, pipeline, and oil and gas production and software industries.

His career began in family-owned electrical and oil field services companies in Texas and Louisiana, and evolved to include positions in general and project management at Dow Chemical and Union Carbide engineering groups throughout Texas. He opened an office for Creole Production Services in Alaska and provided support for the building and operations of the Alyeska pipeline.

In the following years, he was actively involved in the design and installation of oil production and power generation facilities in the Middle East (Egypt and Saudi Arabia) and Europe (North Sea). Mr. Andrews then founded Andrews Oil Company, an exploration and production company that drilled and operated in both North and South Texas and Illinois. After selling the company, he then built and operated several gas pipelines in Texas.

Following this period Mr. Andrews created Andrews Project Services to provide project management, consulting and training services to oil and gas, power generation and software development clients. He managed the design and installation of 16 electric and steam generating plants in the U.S., South America, Europe, and the Middle and Far East. These complex projects included supervision of engineering, purchasing, construction and commissioning activities at many foreign locations. This included responsibility for capital budgets, project schedules, risk management, logistics, labor resources and coordination with government regulatory agencies.

Mr. Andrews graduated summa cum laude from the University of Houston with a degree in Electrical Engineering and Power Technology. He is a certified Scrum Master and a member of the International Mensa Society. He serves on the boards of several charitable foundations, including the Marbridge foundation, an enterprise devoted to life time care for learning disabled citizens. Currently he is an associate of Rice University where he teaches and mentors students at Lovett College.
